Unique design expression - obvious function

In conjunction with the renovation of the National Museum in Stockholm, a number of designers were given the opportunity to create a new inspiring public space, with an interior based solely on new design. A total of 80 new objects were created, including Mela, designed by Matti Klenell, which is now being put into production.

Mela is a family of luminaires consisting of a wall luminaire in two designs and a pendant luminaire in three sizes. Mela's task is to provide the room with both general light, directional light and more informal functional lighting.

Technical specifications

Light source	For 230V LED light sources, a mix of GU10 and E27 socket in the different shades. Light sources with color temperature 2700K are included in the delivery. 3000K can be supplied on request.
Reflector	The shade's inside is finished in a crisp white lacquer, enhancing light distribution to create a bright, even glow with a high efficiency.
Material	Shade and ceiling cup in spun aluminium. Rod in partly recycled steel.
Installation	Suspended in hook and wire suspension.
Connection	Supplied with 3 m textile cable 2G0,75 mm ² in similar colour as shade and ceiling cup. Ceiling cup with terminal block 3x2,5mm ² . Ceiling plug is not included, but can be ordered separately if needed.



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
